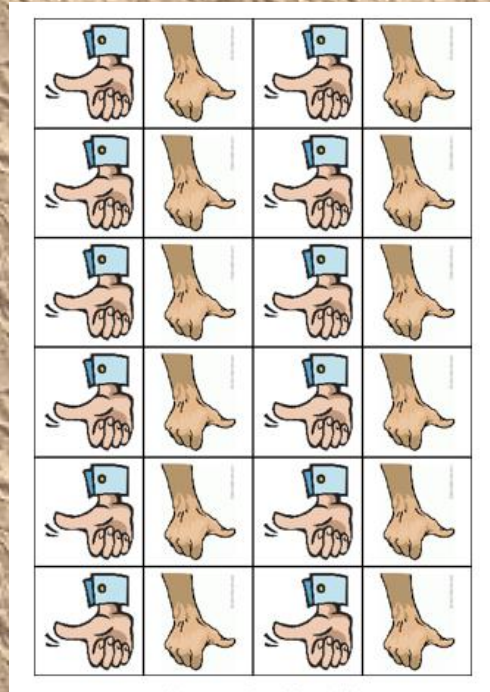

Following the Rules: Older Version

- Differentiation

- Option
 - Print onto cardstock and laminate
 - Add Velcro to empty boxes and back of thumbs pictures
 - Makes a reusable and independent task
