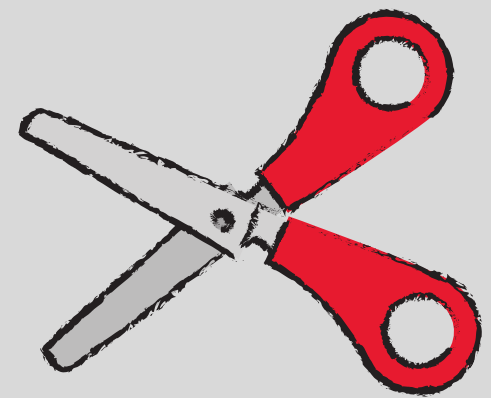
This literacy unit is great for back to school. It is a great way to review some basic skills and get students warmed up and into a routine.



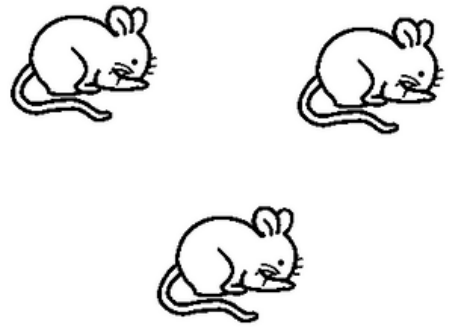
There is a vocabulary board with this unit. This is a great way to encourage ALL students to participate in conversations and stay engaged during activities.



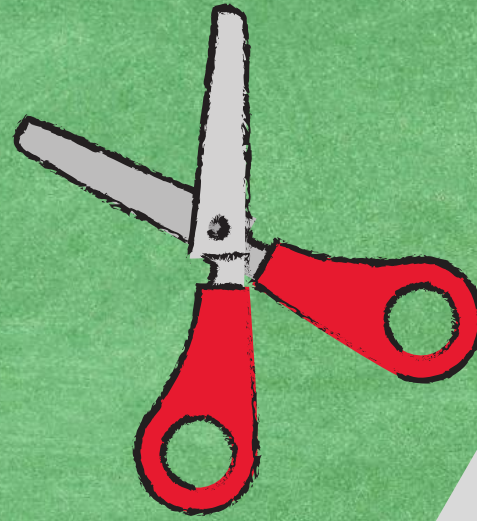
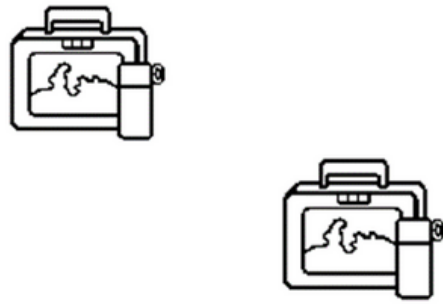
Rather than a typical comprehension check, this unit has 2 cause and effect worksheets that review events from the story.



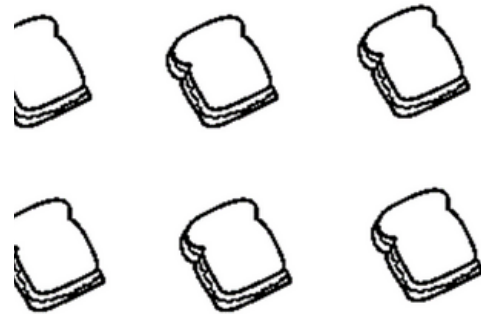
How many mice do you see?

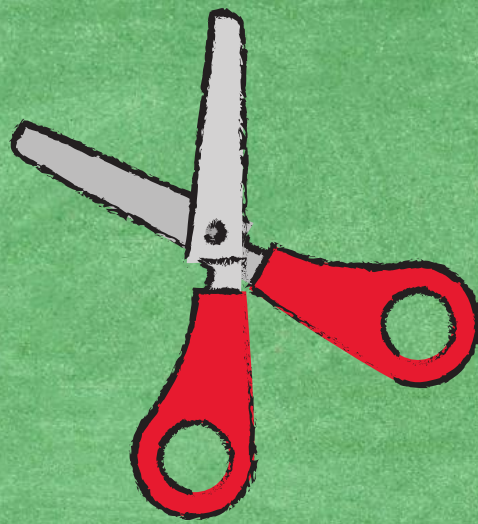
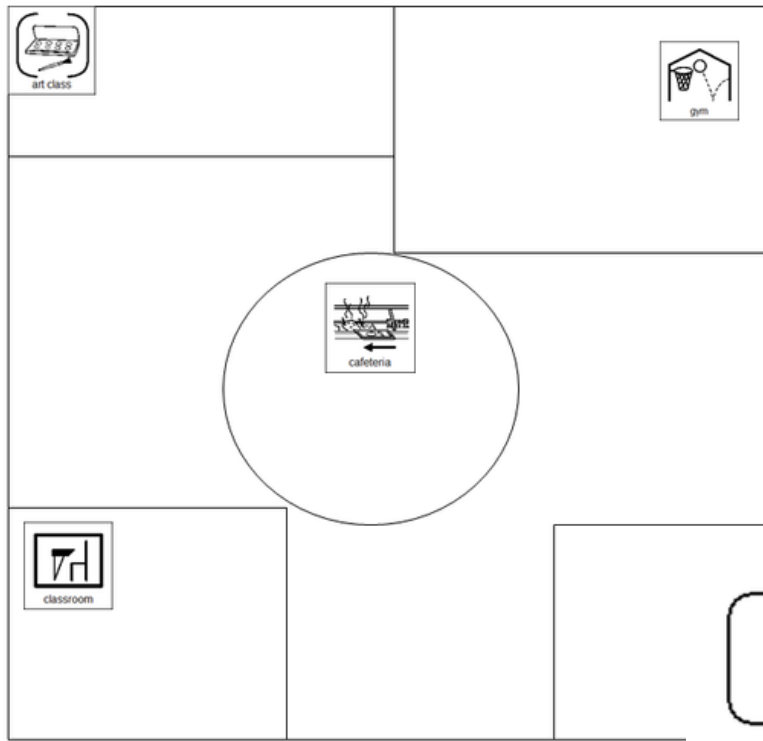


The mouse is the sandwiches.

Students glue the mouse in the circle and then choose the correct preposition to place in the square.

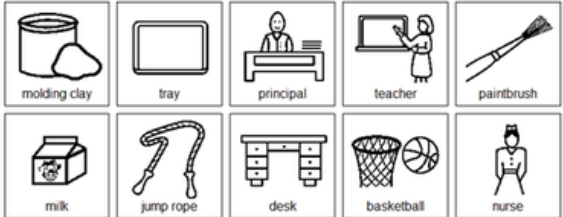
