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


There are a lot of symbols and traditions that surround this holiday.




There is a circle map that reviews the main points from the book.

- One has wrong answers mixed in students will have to set aside





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There is a sequencing worksheet about the life of St. Patrick. There are suggestions for differentiation included.






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

There is a simple worksheet where students will color in squares related to St. Patrick's Day.





Finally, there is a writing prompt for students to complete. This is a great way for students to write their own stories. It is an errorless activity.






I realize there will be some students out there unable to do cutting activities. I have a blog post with ways to complete activities without a pair of scissors!!
