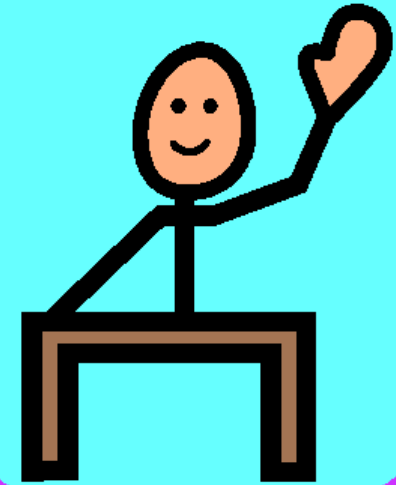

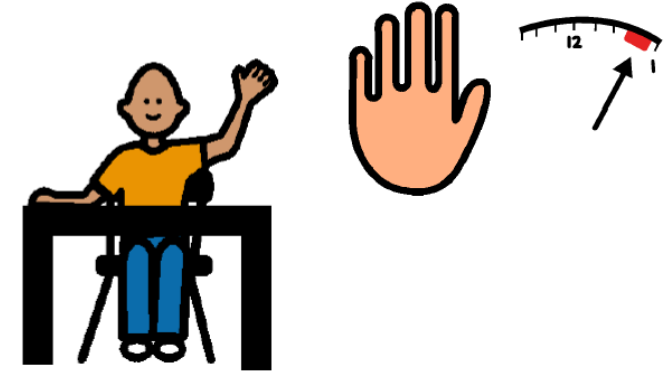
It is hard for the teacher to hear one student talk if everyone else is talking, too.



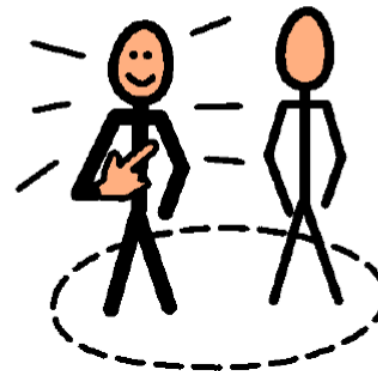
Sometimes the teacher will call on someone else to talk. I may have to wait for my turn to talk.

Sometimes the teacher will call on me to talk.

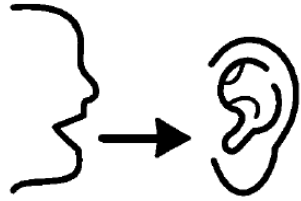

But we cannot all talk at the same time.

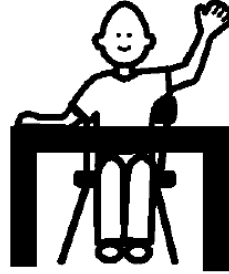


The teacher can only listen to one student at a time.



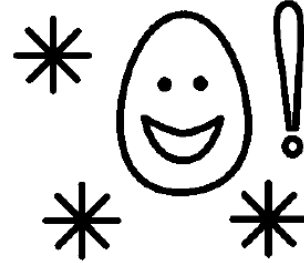

Remember

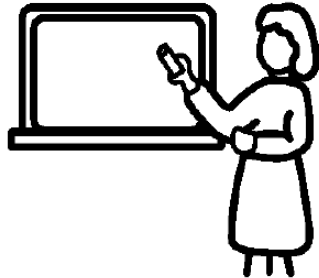
1. Raise my hand
