This led to many books and papers being written, exploring new ways of thinking.





This allowed people to belong to whatever church they wanted and believe whatever they wanted. This greatly diminished the power of the church.

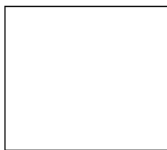

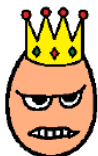
Age of Enlightenment
