The colonists captured 800 British troops and The Continental army regained their confidence in their ability to win the war.

George Washington was the commander of the Continental Army during the Revolutionary War. He had previously fought and led troops in the French and Indian war as well. After the Revolutionary war, he was elected as the first president of the United States.

Most of the things that led to the Revolutionary War were increased attempts by Great Britain to collect money from the colonists and tell them what they could and could not do.






Thomas Jefferson


Boston Massacre
