

5 day lesson plan

Spelling Lesson Plan

Preparation

- · Print out a vocabulary board for each student to use throughout unit
 - o Laminate or place in page protector
- Book
 - o Print out, laminate, and bind
 - o OR your students can listen to the pre-recorded version
- Flash cards
 - o Print out a set of cards onto cardstock and laminate
 - Make one set for each student and also one for the teacher to use in I Spy games

Preassessment (do day 1 before starting lesson)

- . Choose the spelling test that best fits the learning level of your students
- Give the spelling test to assess what your students may already know
- I cannot emphasize enough how important this step is. If you want to see growth, this preassessment is so important!!

Teaching Tips

- Color Coding: this is a really easy way to add more structure to a matching or
 most cut and paste activities. Outline or color in an empty box or sorting label.
 Outline or color in the corresponding picture symbols the same colors. Becomes a
 color matching task.

- Make you own copies of the activities: Every day I review the activity we did yesterday. For that reason:
 - a. I often complete the activity myself and often laminated it for easy review that I could use year after year.
 - My copies were also helpful as either a model for students who needed more support or as a way for more advanced students to self-check their work.

Activity	Notes	Materials
Read or listen to a recording of the book (10 minutes)	Since this is the first time students are seeing the book, I focus a lot on the word family Ask lots of questions about what they might think the pictures mean or may relate to Make connections between book and vocabulary board (have students find relevant symbols on their boards to go with a concept or photo on page.) as well as flash cards	Book Vocabulary board Flash cards
Flash cards (5 minutes)	 Look at the file included and choose an activity to do with the flash cards: Awesome Activities for Vocabulary boards 	Flash cards Vocabulary board
Circle Map (10 minutes)	 Do one of the circle maps provided Choose the best version (errorless or not) depending on the learning level of your students Students cut out symbols or photos and place in circle map. You can also choose to use the photos. Make connections to the book as necessary 	Circle map Scissors Glue
Matching activity 1 (10 minutes)	 Do the picture to picture matching activity Choose to use either the photos or symbols depending on the learning level of your student Use color coding as needed 	Worksheet Scissors Glue
Sharing (10 minutes)	Each student shares one of their finished activities with the group using the communication method of their choice This repetition is so important. Students are hearing the relevant vocabulary when: Read the story Review the vocabulary cards and board Complete the circle map Share the circle map	Completed activity Communication devices


