  - Make one set for each student and also one for the teacher to use in 1 Spy


#### Preassessment (do day 1 before starting lesson)

- . Choose the spelling test that best fits the learning level of your students
- Give the spelling test to assess what your students may already know
- . I cannot emphasize enough how important this step is. If you want to see growth, this preassessment is so important!!

#### Teaching Tips

- 1. Color Coding: this is a really easy way to add more structure to a matching or most cut and paste activities. Outline or color in an empty box or sorting label. Outline or color in the corresponding picture symbols the same colors. Becomes a color matching task.


