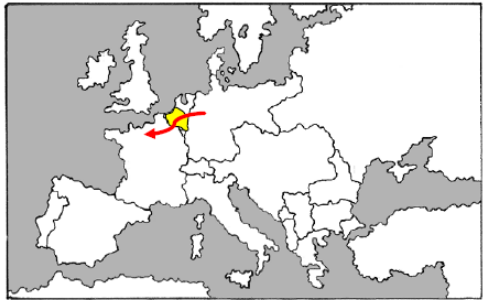

During the attack on France, Germany decided to go through Belgium. Belgium was a small country that was supposed to remain neutral in any war and was therefore protected from being involved. Germany ignored this.



Things were done very differently in this war than before. The soldiers on both sides, dug miles and miles of **trenches** or deep ditches. The soldiers lived in and fought from these trenches.



Life in Britain was not easy during this time. For the first time, people were being attacked from the air with weapons as well as from the sea.

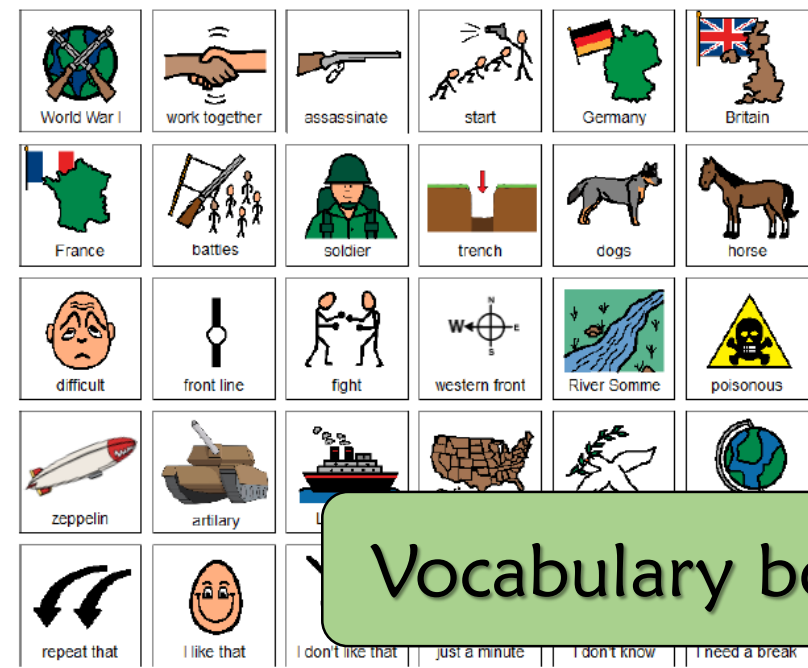


Occasionally, soldiers were sent into **No-Man's Land** to continue fighting. This was the area between the German and British trenches and was an incredibly dangerous place to be.



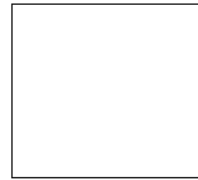
In July 1916, the deadliest battle of the war (and of all time) occurred. It was the **Battle of the Somme**.

Archduke of Austria who was killed by a Serbia group. It was the start of World War I.



Battle of Mons

Germany attack France in Belgium in August 1914 and would be the reason that Britain would enter the war, truly starting World War I.



assassinate

Kill (an important person) in a surprise attack for political reasons.

The area between the German and British trenches and was an incredibly dangerous place to be.

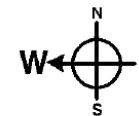
