There are 5 activities to go with this book to last a full week of instruction.


This unit comes with a storyboard.

Place the following in the circle map on the previous page, showing things you could do with and in the snow.




Place the following in the circle map on the previous page **ONLY IF** they are things you could do with and in the snow.




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There is a circle map about things you can do in the snow. There is an option that only has correct answers and one that has wrong answers mixed in.



When the Snow Falls



When the snow falls, I put on my .

When the snow falls, I get out my .


We go outside and when the snow falls.


Students will write a story about what they like to do when snow falls. This is an errorless activity that allows students to write their own story independently.










Place the following in the circle showing things that can fall.
