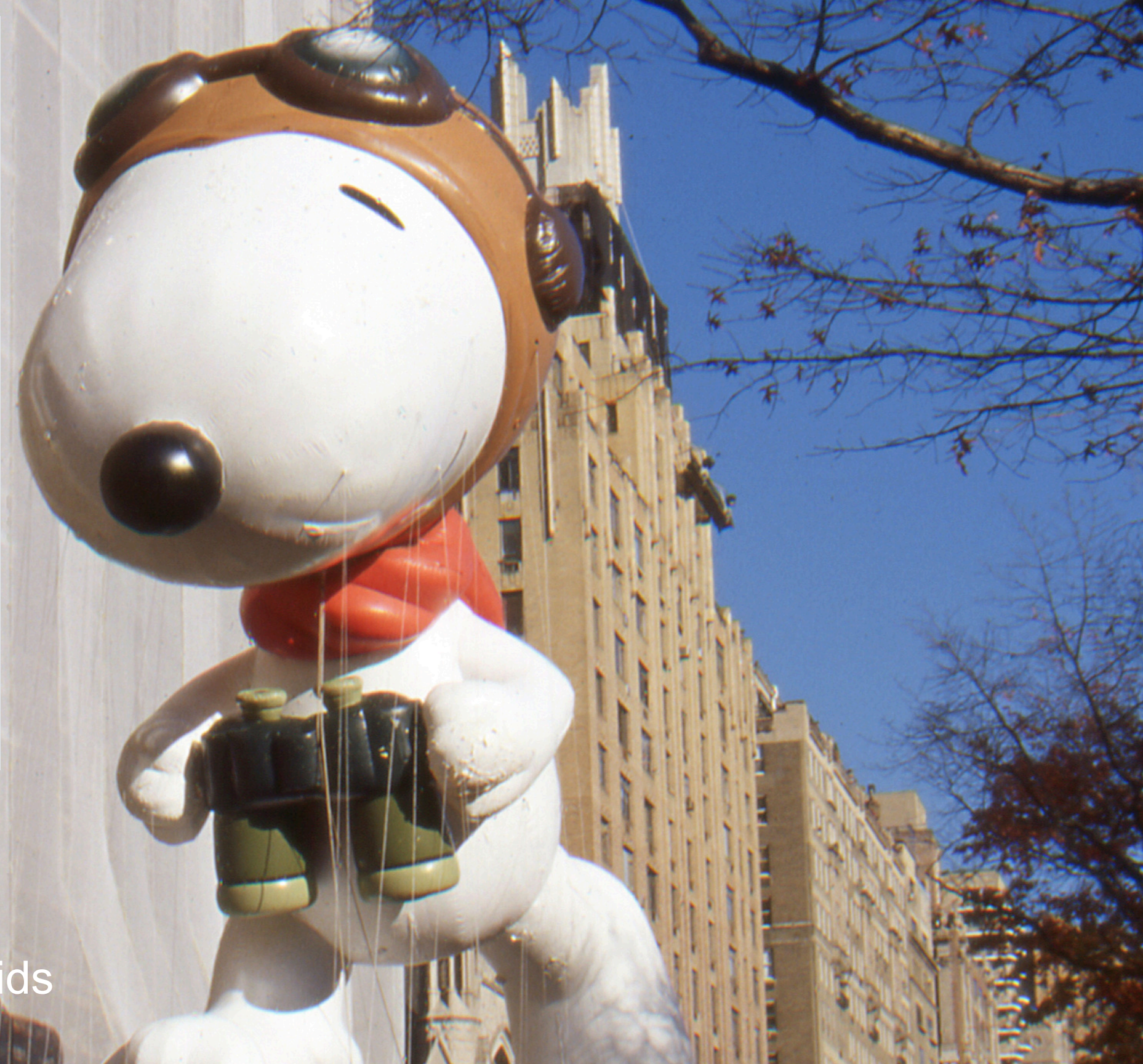

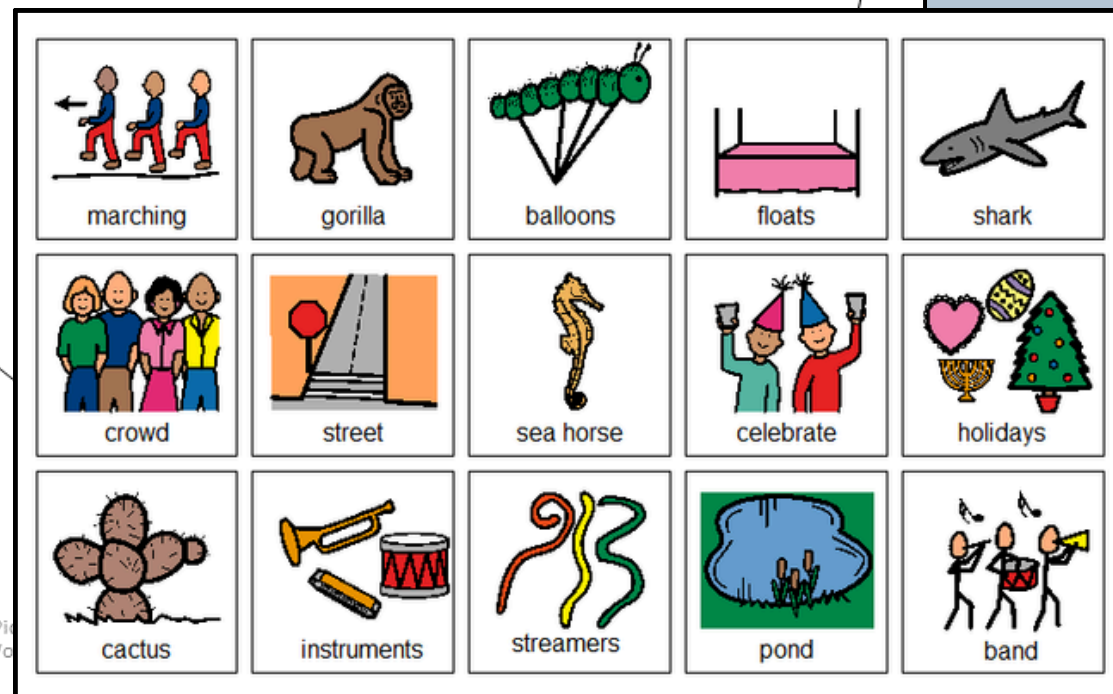
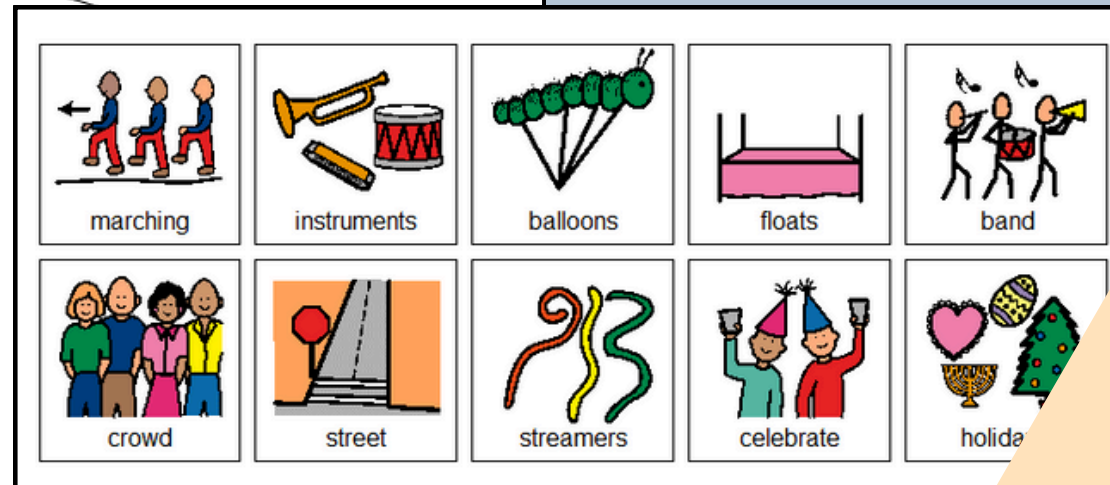

ERRORLESS

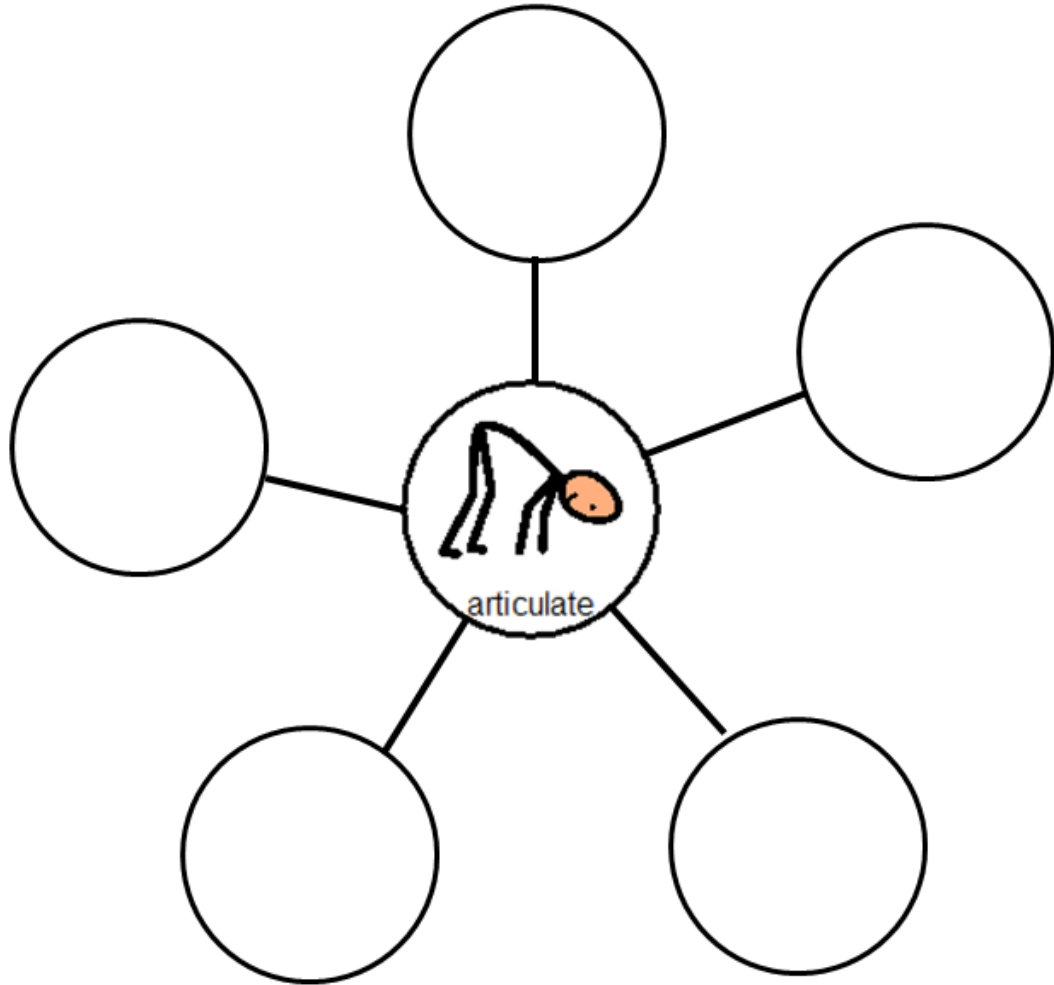


There is a circle map. It looks at things you often find at a parade. It comes with two choices:







What are some things that articulate?

This is an errorless activity.

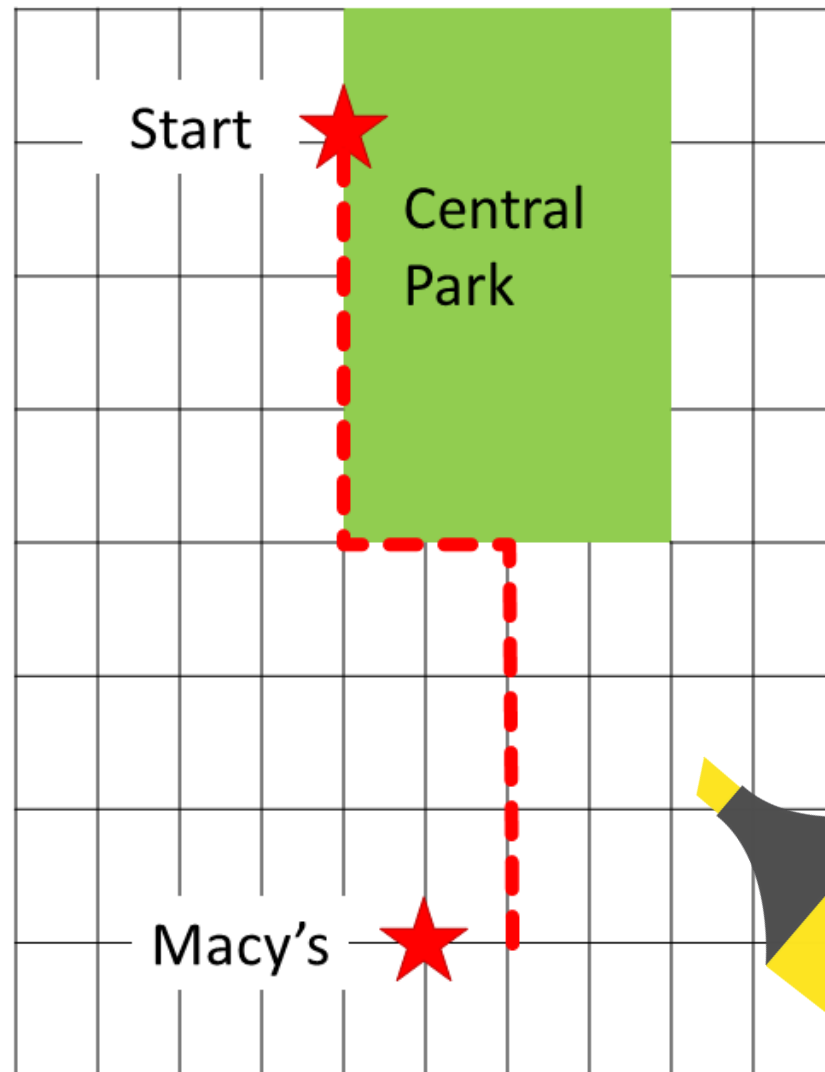
