
This unit has 5 activities to go with this book to last a full week of instruction.

There are 2 separate files, one in color and one in black and white.

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









































This unit comes with a storyboard.

Cut out the pictures and place in the circle map on the previous page ONLY IF they were things Duck did.

































There is a circle map showing all the things Duck did to campaign. There is an option that only has correct answers and one that has wrong answers mixed in.








There is a word map showing what the word campaign actually means. This is an errorless activity.












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

What would each person be covered with by the end of the day?































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There is a matching activity, matching what each person would be covered with at the end of the day depending on their job. There is a differentiated version included.






Students will write a story about why Duck would make a good president. This is an errorless activity that allows students to write their own story independently.
