






This unit comes with a storyboard.

Storyboards are great for ALL students to assist with participation and engagement in group discussions.






There is a circle map looking at different ways you can keep track of time. There is an option that only has correct answers and one that has wrong answers mixed in.









Here are some pictures of the Arctic. Can you imagine what it would feel like to live here?








## Perfect for every learning level
