## Summer Lesson Plan

#### Preparation

- · Print out a vocabulary board for each student to use throughout unit
  - Laminate or place in page protector
- Book
  - o Print out, laminate, and bind
  - o OR your students can listen to the pre-recorded version
- · Scavenger Hunt cards
  - Print on cardstock and laminate
- Bingo Boards
  - o Print cards on cardstock and laminate
  - o Cut apart one board to use as calling cards

#### Preassessment (do day 1 before starting lesson)

- · For this unit, use the fill-in-the-blank worksheets as the assessment for this unit.
- . Give the guiz to assess what your students may already know
- I cannot emphasize enough how important this step is. If you want to see growth, this preassessment is so important!!

#### Teaching Tips

- Color Coding: this is a really easy way to add more structure to a matching activity. Outline or color in an empty box or sorting label. Outline or color in the corresponding picture symbols the same colors. Becomes a color matching task.


Vocabulary boards are great for ALL students to assist with participation and engagement in group discussions.

How many suns do you see?














## Summer Scavenger Hunt


- · Make a copy of the following page for each student.

## Bingo cards




- · Included are 10 Bingo cards in color and 10 Bingo cards in BW.

    - · Dot markers








