
The lesson plans contain:

### Group Activity 1: Make a set of tally marks

- This gives students a chance to create a set of tally mark using physical objects.
- This will help reinforce the quantity a set of 5 tally marks represents.
- · Print template onto cardstock.
- · Glue down the objects in the dashed marks.
- Suggestion to use: (may need to be trimmed down to size)
  - Pipe cleaners
  - Pieces of yarn Make you own set of tally marks.
  - Craft sticks
  - Straws
  - Sticks
  - Chopsticks

### Group Activity 2: Counting with tally marks

- Here are 20 flashcards with the quantities of 1-20 using tally mark.
- There are several ways to use these:
  - · Count out a group of objects and have students match the correct flashcard to the quantity
  - · Have students draw a card and create a group of objects with the same quantity
  - · Sequence a set of 5 cards from greatest to least
  - · Place the flash cards on a large number line
  - Make 4 sets and play Go Fish
  - · Make 2 sets and play concentration
  - · Place a set around the room and go on a scavenger hunt











