



There are 2 separate files, one in color and one in black and white.

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


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This unit comes with a storyboard.

Tips on how to use in the unit!!




Tops and Bottoms cards

- · Make a copy of each card on cardstock or mount on heavy paper.
- · They are in color and black and white.
- · Color and laminate
- · Cut in half (cut the corn in 3 pieces)
- Pass out before reading the story. As you get to each vegetable being discussed, have students give the bear and the hare the correct part of the vegetable.
- I mounted the bear and hare on the white board, and students would put the vegetable halves below each one as we were reading.


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


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Radish: Bear got tops and hare got bottoms.





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


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There are 9 large picture cards used for a group activity. Suggestions for differentiation are included.


