

Spelling Lesson Plan

Preparation

- Print out a vocabulary board for each student to use throughout unit
 - o Laminate or place in page protector
- Book
 - o Print out, laminate, and bind
 - o OR your students can listen to the pre-recorded version
- Flash cards
 - o Print out a set of cards onto cardstock and laminate
 - Make one set for each student <u>and also</u> one for the teacher to use in 1 Spy games

Preassessment (do day 1 before starting lesson)

- . Choose the spelling test that best fits the learning level of your students
- . Give the spelling test to assess what your students may already know
- I cannot emphasize enough how important this step is. If you want to see growth, this preassessment is so important!!

Teaching Tips

- Color Coding: this is a really easy way to add more structure to a matching or most cut and paste activities. Outline or color in an empty box or sorting label. Outline or color in the corresponding picture symbols the same colors. Becomes a color matching task.

 - My copies were also helpful as either a mode more support or as a way for more advances work.








If you do not want to print the book out, there is a link to a movie version (mp4 file) that you can play in a google slide online or project. It is read aloud and has automatic page advancement.
