





You will see lots of different types of grasses here as well as prickly pear cactus, sagebrush, cattails, and willows.



Tropical grasslands or savannas mainly experience two seasons, a rainy season and a dry season. Both are warm, and 15-25 inches of rain will usually fall during the rainy season.

It comes in a PowerPoint version as well as a voicerecorded PowerPoint (so you don't have to print it out.) There is also a movie version you can use in google slides.

There is a 45-page book with simple text and engaging photos.

savannas Tropical grasslands mainly found in Africa.


