

















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This unit comes with a vocabulary board.


What are some things to remember as you head back to school?

Cut apart pictures and place in circle map ONLY IF they are examples of following the rules.


































Activity

Think about the rules in your school. Which of the things on the next page are good choices and which are not?



Activity #4


Students will complete another circle map about how they are feeling about coming back to school. This only has one version, and feelings they do not use are set aside.

Students will write about how they are feeling about coming back to school. Again, this is an errorless activity.














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Structured Picture Walks

- This strategy is great for students with disabilities because it has a clear purpose and a definitive end.
- I would use this structured walk every day for the first 2 weeks.
- Teacher preparation:
 - Make 2 copies of the pictures on page 3/4 on cardstock.
 Laminate for durability.
 - Place one set around the school in common locations your students will visit.
- Pass out the second set to the students, divided by ability level, i.e. some students can handle more than others.
- Explain the purpose of the walk is to find a picture that matches one they have while following the school rules.
- Once all the pictures have been matched, the walk is over.
- For some of my students, I made a matching template with blank circles. That way they could clearly see how many matches they needed and when the task was complete.
- For many students, anxiety arises when either:
 - 1. They do not know what is expected of them
 - Don't know how long a task (especially one not preferred) will last
- This structure helps minimize that anxiety and makes the walk much more reinforcing.

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Group Activity

Students will practice routines in the hallway and around the school using a structured walk.

Directions and materials are included.

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Bingo cards



- · Included are 10 Bingo cards in color and 10 Bingo cards in BW.
- Place the cards in page protectors or laminate for long term use.
- Calling cards are included.
- This is a great way to practice the new vocabulary included in this unit.
- · Cut apart a set of the vocabulary cards to use as the calling cards.
- · Options:
 - · Show students the picture for them to match
 - · Read the definition and see if students can find the matching picture
 - · Work as teams
 - · Vary the "winning" patterns.
 - Cover all
 - Cover corners
 - Row across or down
 - · Cover the edges
 - Vary the ways to mark the card
 - · Place in page protector or lami
 - Stickers
 - · Post-it notes
 - · Dot markers






