After World War 2 in the 1940's Korea split into 2 separate countries. North Korea was led by communist rule, and the south had a more democratic or capitalist government. They country was divided along the 38th parallel.



For a long time, neither the North or the South could make any headwaj across the 38th parallel. They simply stayed there and fought while holdir, their position.

This unit contains a 26 page book that reviews the main facts about the war using photos and simple text.

Both books come in a PowerPoint version as well as a voice-recorded PowerPoint (so you don't have to print it out.) There are also movie versions you can use in google slides.

armistice


A pause in fighting brought about by agreement between the two sides.

Communist leader of North Korea during the war.


