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



Read or listen to a recording of the book (10 minutes)	Read through the story, asking lots of questions Continue to make connections between book and vocabulary board	Book Vocabulary board
Vocabulary cards <mark>Speed Matching</mark> (10 minutes)	place all the cards in the middle of the table hold up a card, and the students race to find it in the pile in the middle of the table NOTE: for students with physical challenges, allow them to simply find the symbol on their board or communication device	Vocabulary cards (extra sets)

proxy war

A war instigated by a major power that

does not itself become involved.



South Vietnam

Part of Vietnam that was more democratic and led by Ngo Dinh Diem; supported by the US



Military draft

Requirement of any eligible citizen (usually men over 18) to go to war if needed.



communism

System where all property is owned by the government and everyone works for the common good of all people.



A sudden, violent, and illegal seizure of power from a government.


