

Pig circle map – Use with Chapter 2


- Circle maps are a great way for students to "see" the big ideas about a subject.
- This includes 2 versions:
 - One version only has correct answers, so all the pictures go in the circle map. This is perfect for your early learners.
 - One version has wrong answers mixed in that students will have to set aside.
 - For the most advanced students, simply give them the circle map without any picture choices and have them find supporting factors from the book or other source.
- Having 2 versions of the same activity allows all students in your group to participate in the same activity at their own learning level.




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


Pig circle map: Cut apart the pictures and place in map on the previous page **ONLY IF** they related to pigs.






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Pig circle map: Cut apart the pictures and place in map on the previous page **ONLY IF** they related to pigs.
