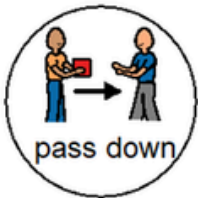

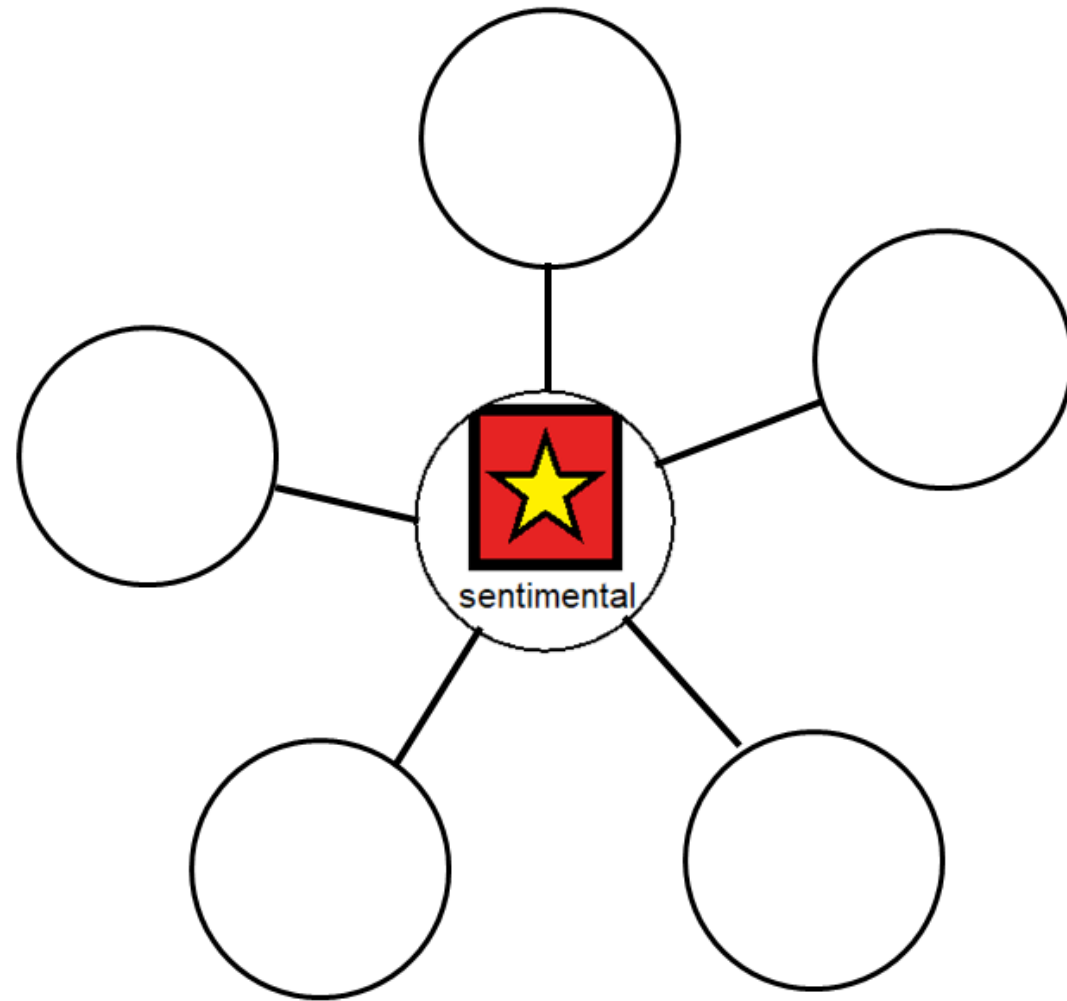

Color in the country of Russia.



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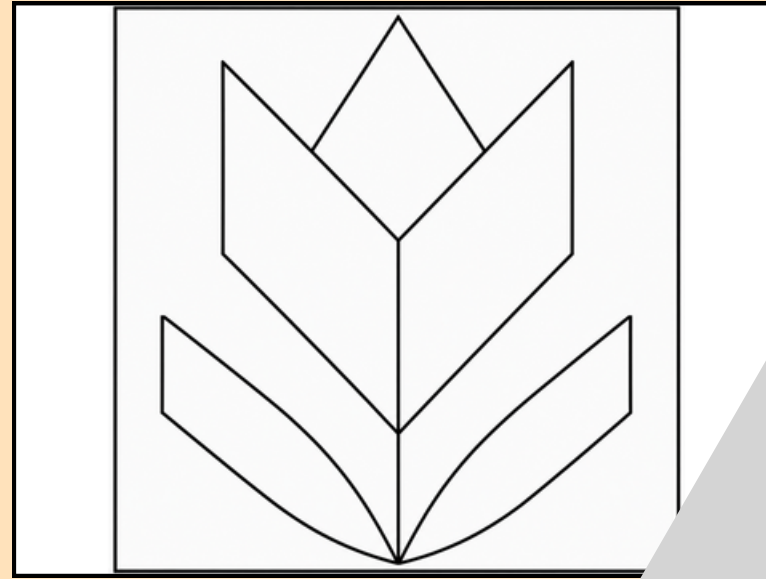
Students will color in a map of Russia.



Make a student quilt

- There are 10 standard quilting blocks included here.
- I would recommend printing them onto cardstock.
- Have students choose a block to color. It is OK if some choose the same block.
- Once they are colored, cut them out on the outer edge.
- On the floor, practice arranging them in different configurations. Layout is everything when it comes to a quilt.
- Once you are happy with the layout, either:
 - Tape them together on the back along the seams
 - Hole punch the sides and tie together with yarn (this works better if you mount each block on a piece of cardboard)
 - Use rolls of masking tape on the back and mount/tape onto the wall

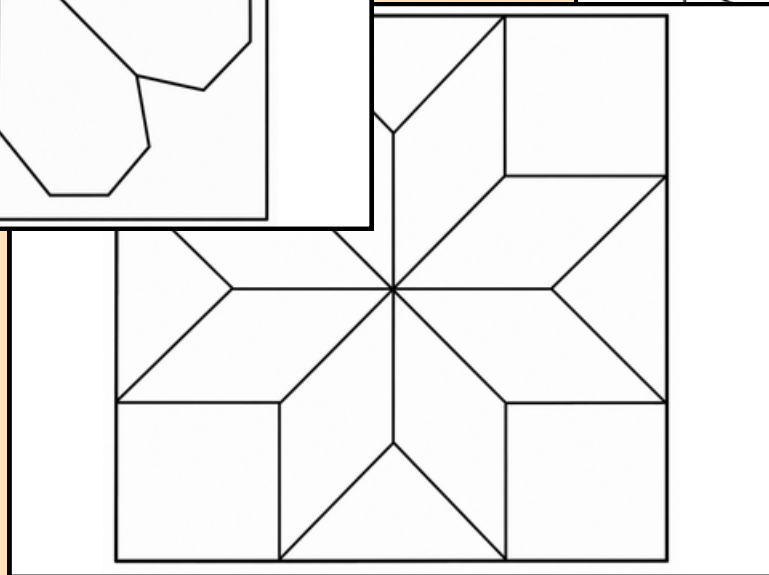
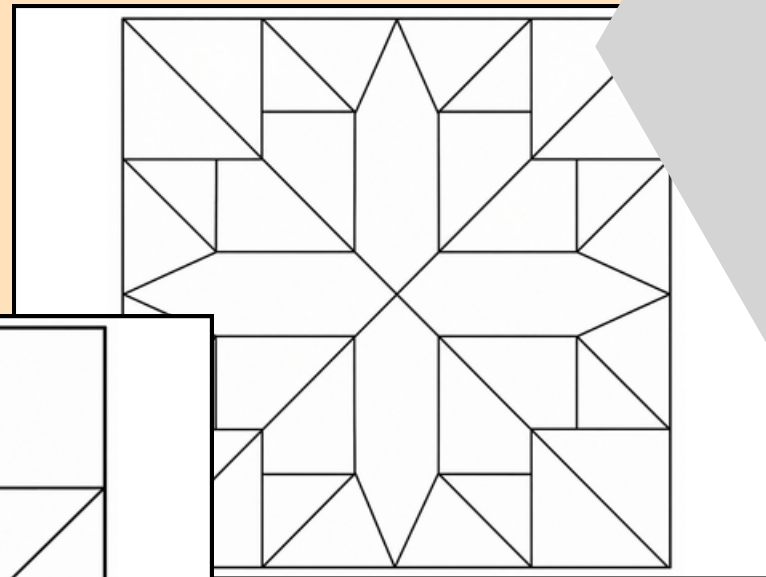
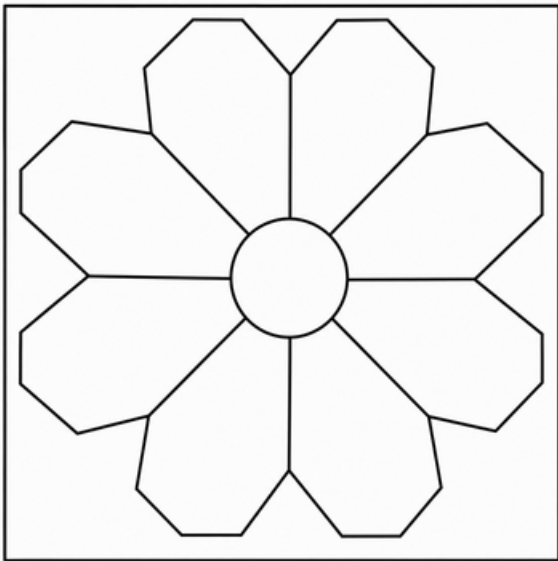
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There are 10 different quilt blocks for students to color.

You can make this into a class quilt.

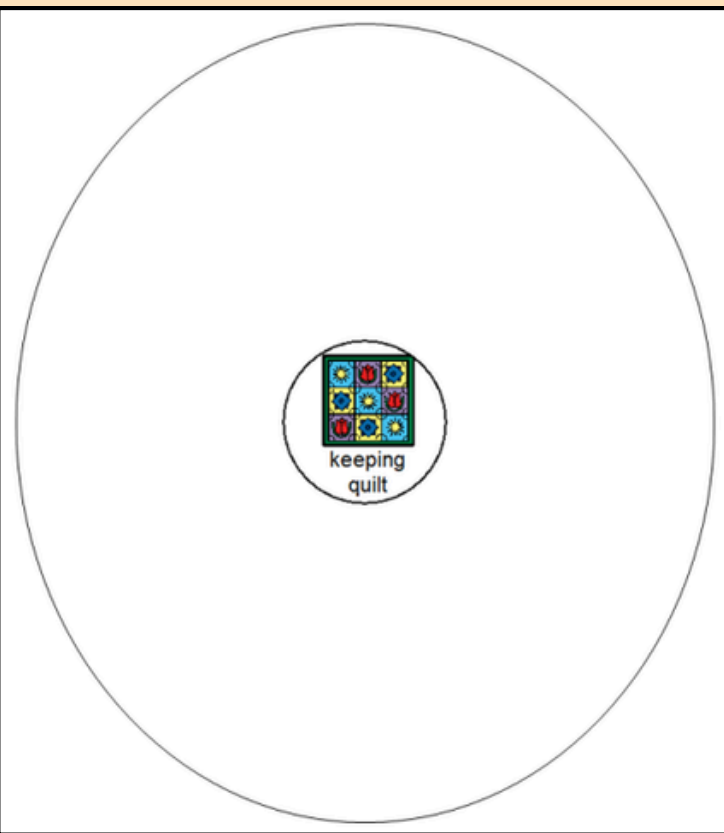
Directions for assembly are included.





There is a video of the book read aloud. This is a video from YouTube.



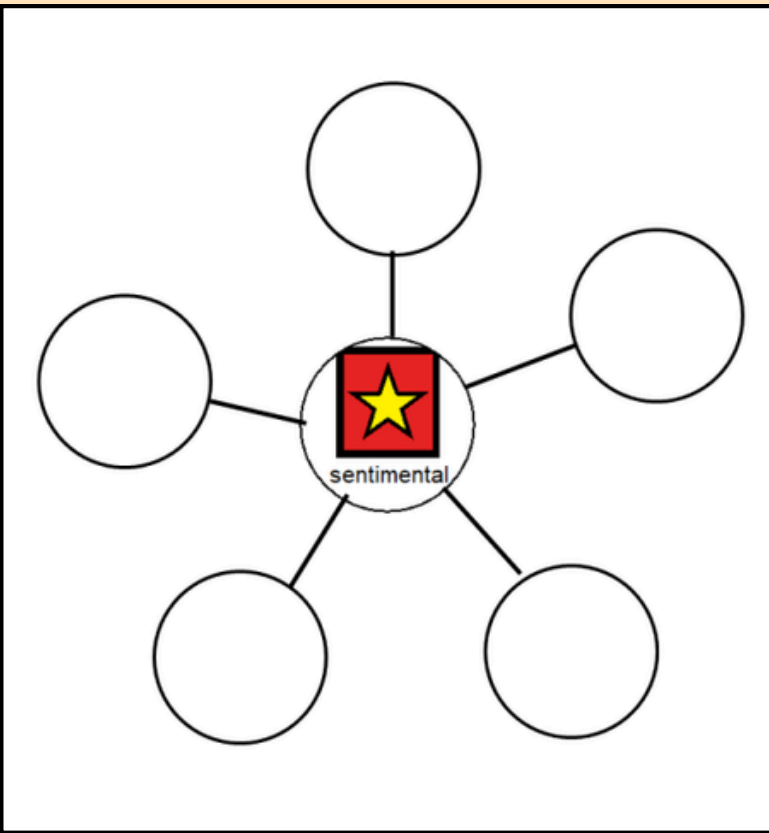


Place the following in the circle map showing things the keeping quilt was used for.
